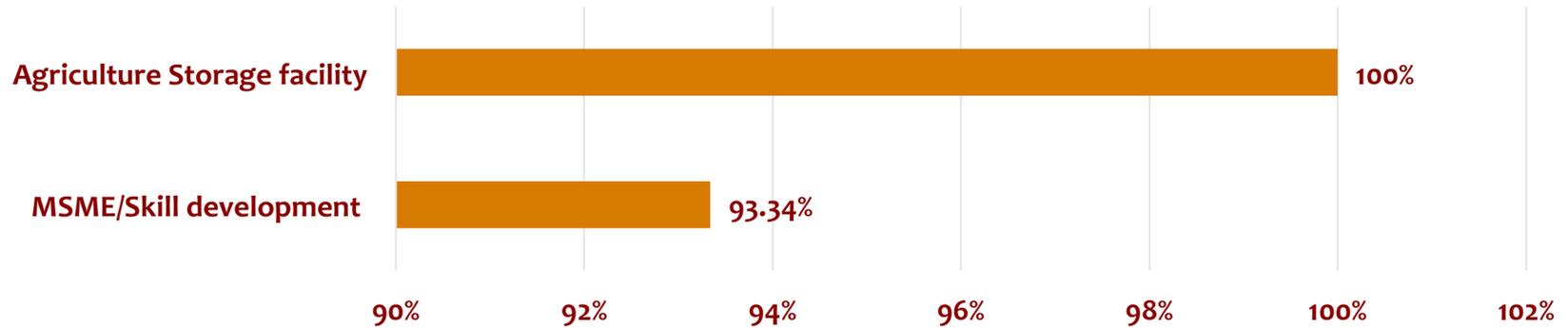

- There is no facility for solid waste, vermicomposting and compost pit in the cluster.

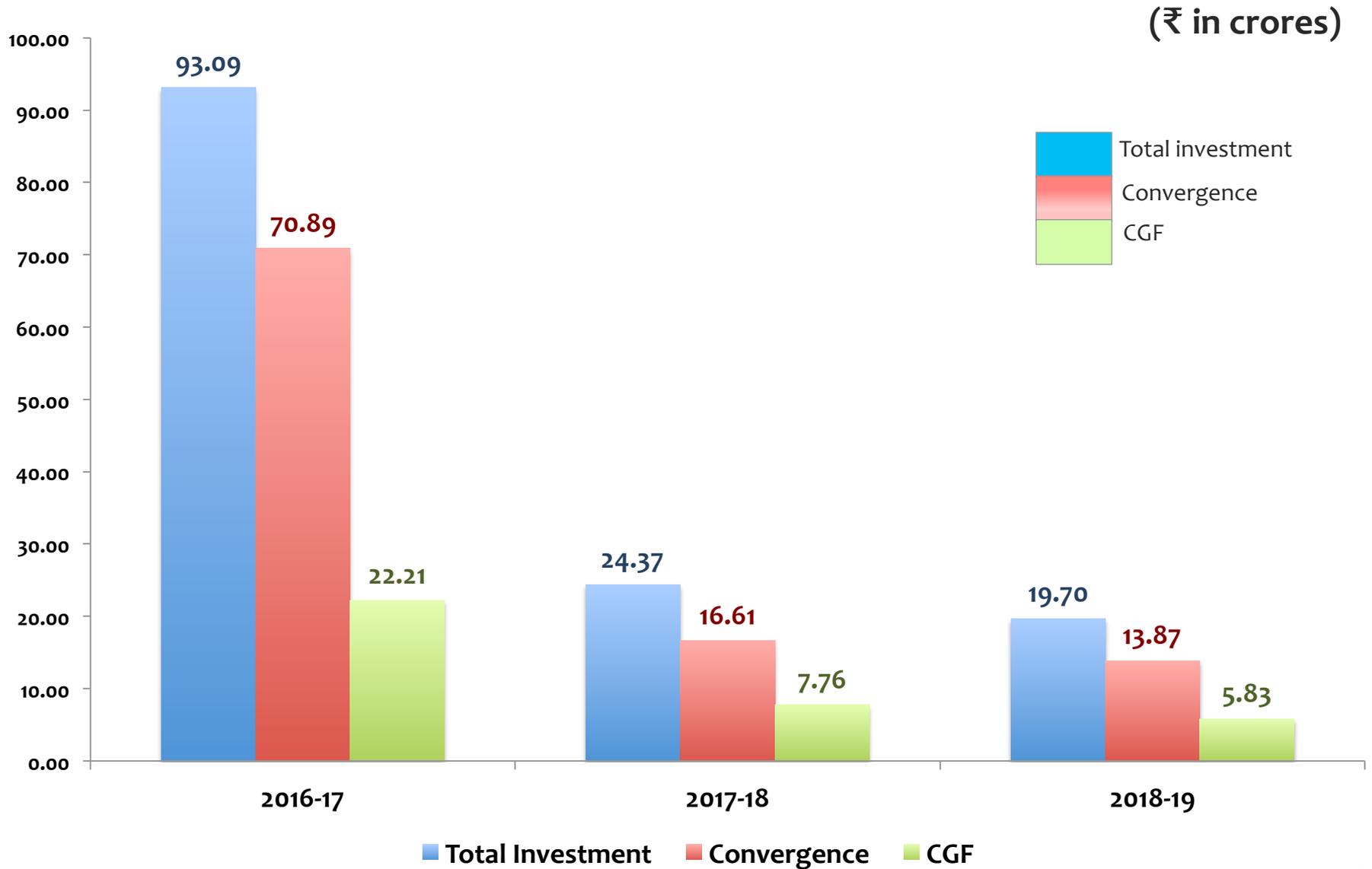

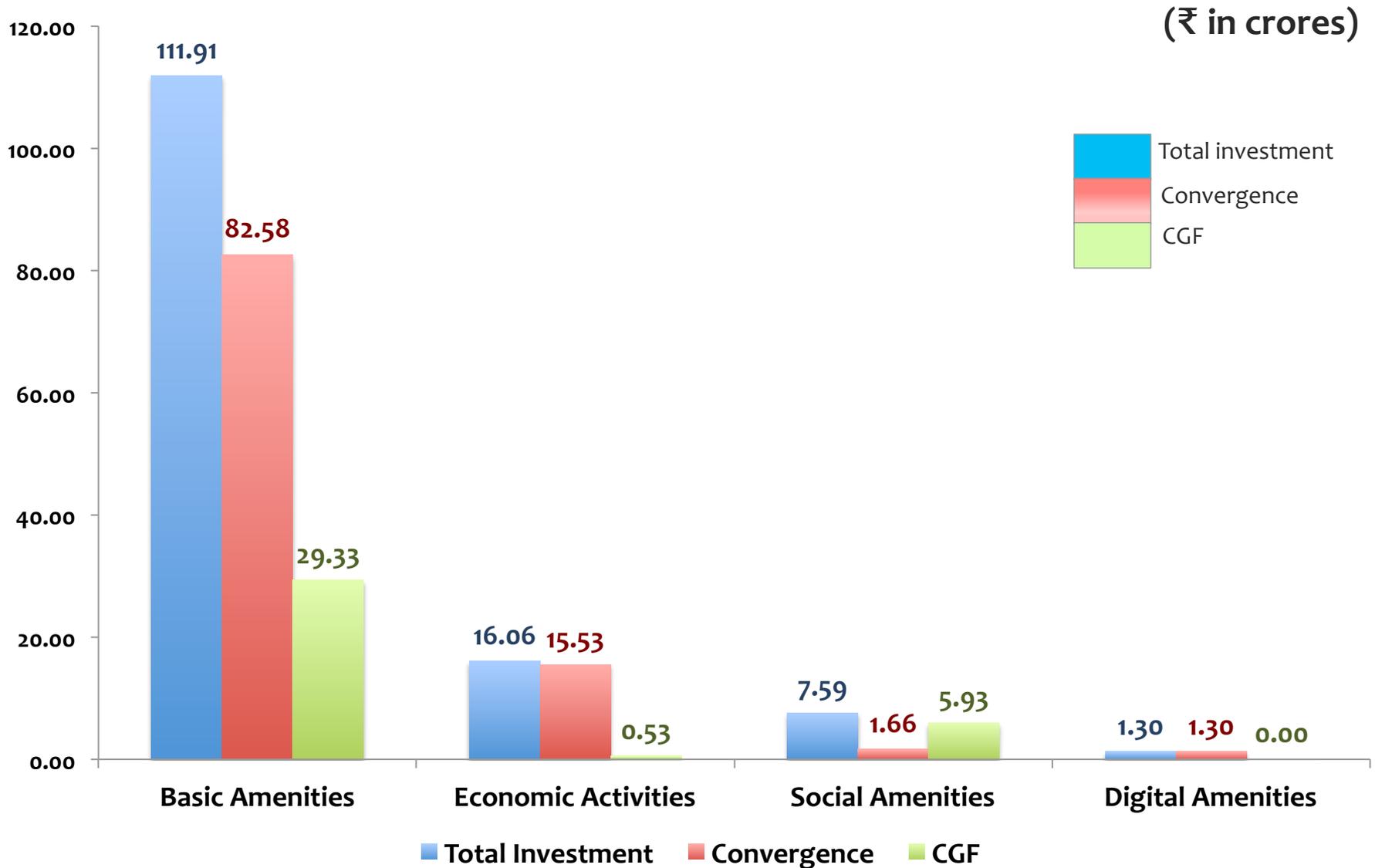

Yearly Phasing of Total Investment & CGF

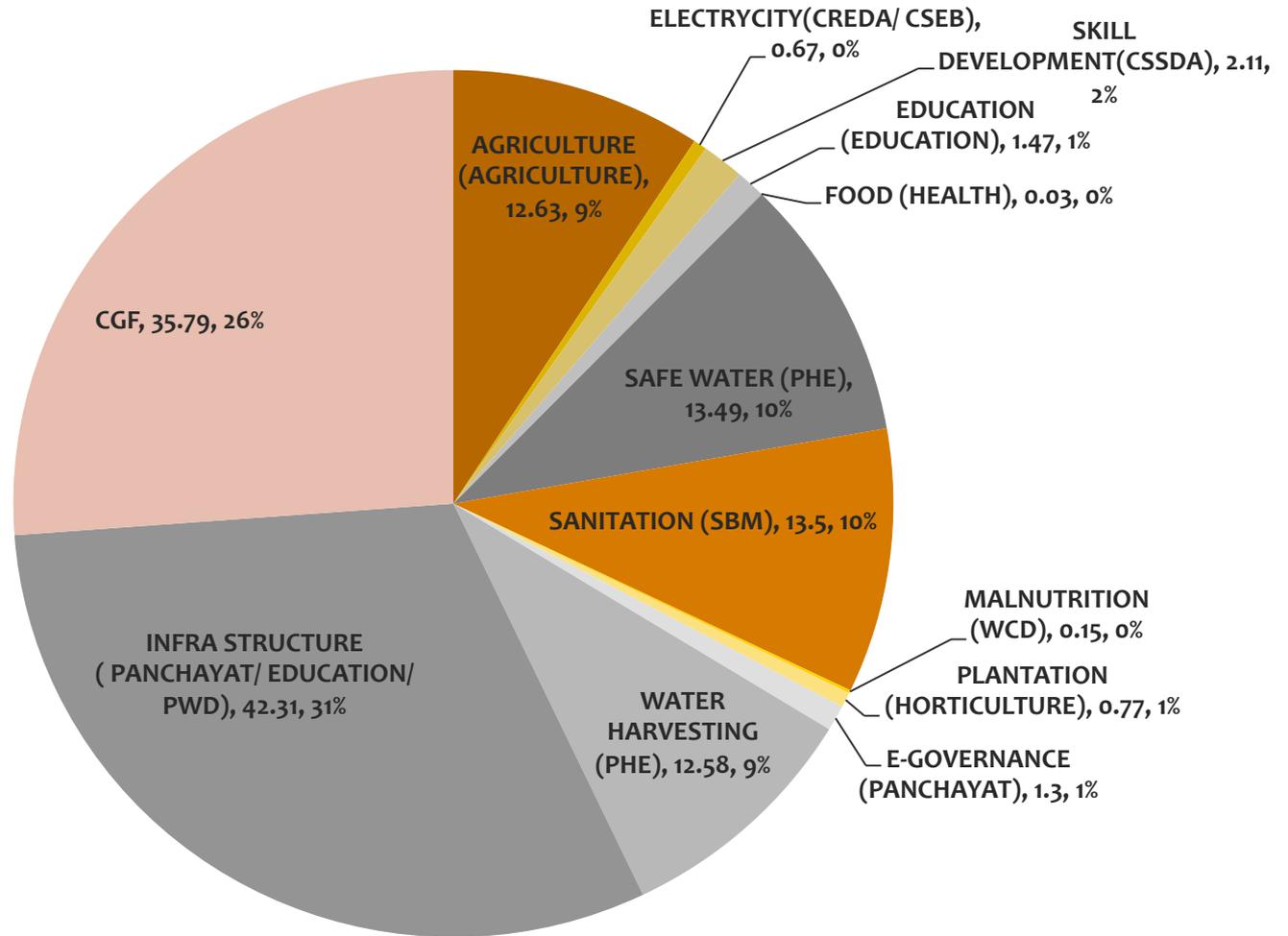


Category wise Investment, CGF and Convergence

Deficiency Analysis and Identification of Needs

- Treatment Center at Cluster level, Collection facility at HH level, Sanitary land fill sites, Composting at village level.
- Public Transport required in 5 GPs, City bus routes need to be modified. E-rickshaw for inter village road connectivity.
- Modernization of all 7 health facilities. 18 Anganwadi buildings required.
- Forming around 650 SHGs and 24 Village organizations in 3 years.
- Dairy establishment to utilize the capacity of the chilling plant, Rejuvenation of Cashew processing plant, Fisheries promotion in 10 ponds, 5 New ponds for fisheries, Irrigation facilities like electrification of pumps, drip and sprinkler, Pipeline extension, Provision of farm equipment through Kisan Service Centres and Solar pump.
- Setting up of plastic cluster and Training 35 people with CIPET
- 1 Citizen Service Centre (CSC) in each GP, total 13 CSC.
- Broad band connectivity in all Panchayats.

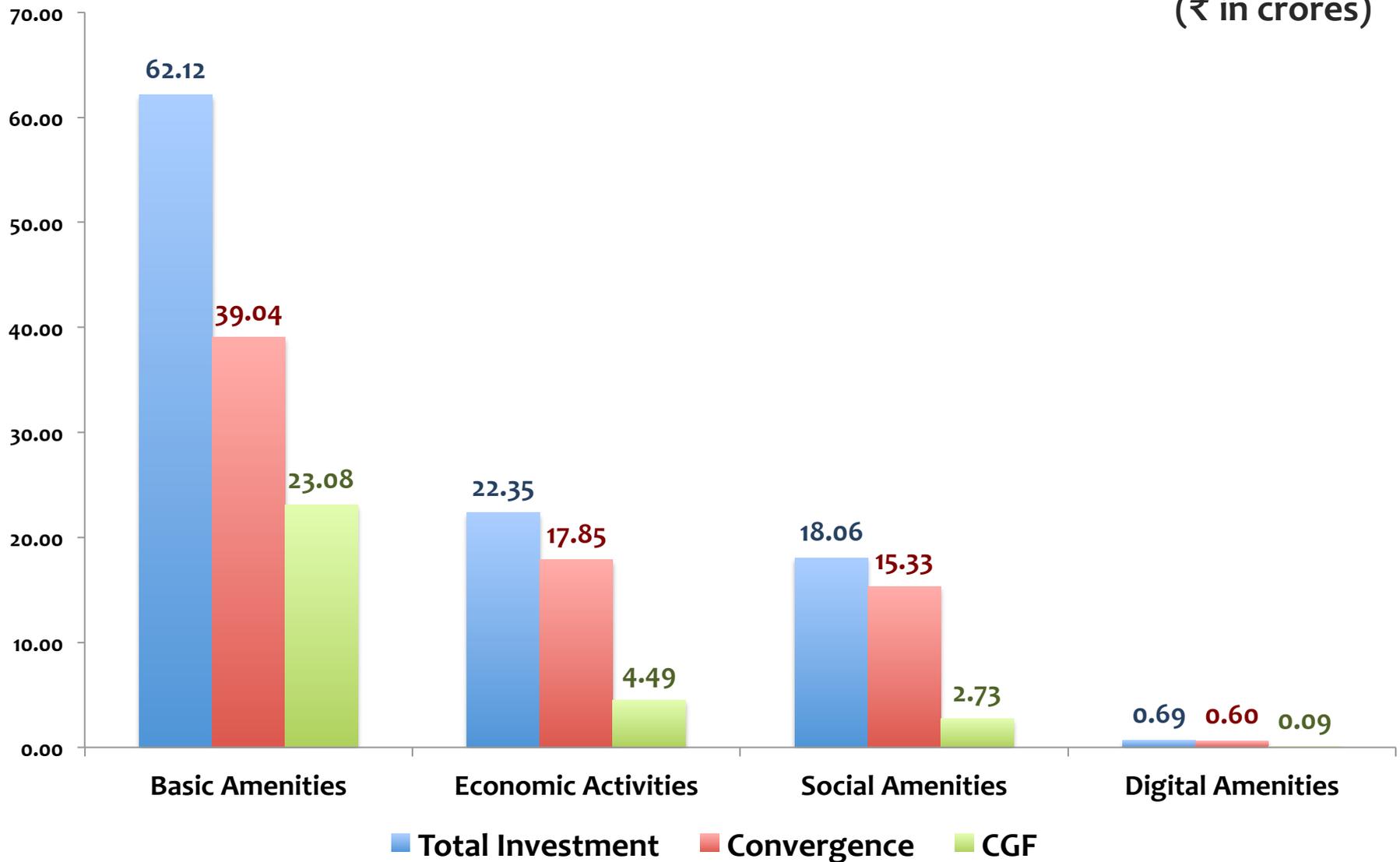

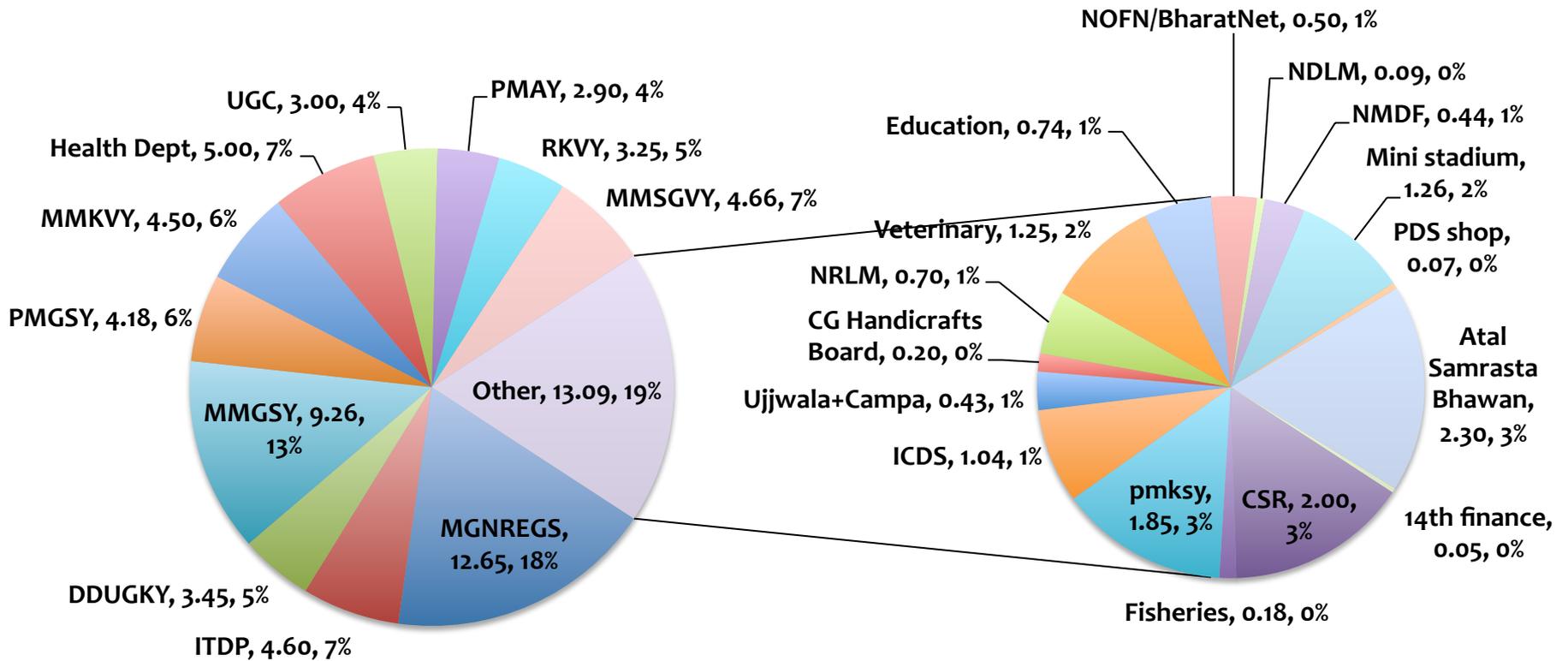
